- Room rates for 2012 are: All room are the same rate. PAYABLE IN ADVANCE
  - \$45 per night single occupancy. (member rate)
  - \$55 per night double occupancy. (member rate)
  - \$65 per night single occupancy. (non-member rate)
  - \$75 double occupancy. (non-member rate)

(The average hotel room in downtown Seattle is over \$120 per night to \$200 per night).

- Weekly rates (7 days or more ) are: PAYABLE IN ADVANCE
  - \$30 per night (single) or \$210 per week. (member rate)
  - \$45 (double) or \$315 per week. (member rate)
  - \$50 per night (single) for 7-14 days \$350 per week. (non-member rate)
  - \$65 per night (double) for 7-14 days \$455 per week. (non-member rate)
- Rooms include linens on beds and towels in 2 bathrooms. One on top floor and one on main floor. Both have tubs with showers.
- Bathrooms are shared by guests. No rooms are en-suite.
- WiFi access is free.
- Kitchen access is included and has silverware, china, pot and pans and cooking utensils. Microwave oven is available. Guests are required to wash any dishes and put them away. No items should be left in the refrigerator upon exit. Please take out kitchen garbage.
- A laundry is available to guests. It is found in the basement (\$1 per wash and \$1 per dry). Laundry soap is supplied at no additional charge.
- No maid service is provided during stay and guests are asked to leave rooms and bathroom clean and the beds stripped upon exit. Place linen in hamper in upstairs hall.

Sprint Street Center is not responsible for valuable left in building. Be sure to lock your room. We hold items one month and then are property of center. If key is lost there is a \$25 key replacement fee. Push lock button to engage dead bolt upon exit to secure building.

A small deck is found off the top floor, where a guest may enjoy a view of the Space Needle, weather permitting.

### **GUEST ROOMS: (Maximum 7 Guests)**

#### **ROOM 1: ONE TWIN BED**

This newly renovated room was just added as a guest room and has a view of the park, great light from large windows and lots of closet space and built in storage.

## **OUR GREAT LOCATION:**

Two nice markets are just two block north on Madison (Trader Joes and Madison Market). Both markets feature many organic food options. Many fine restaurants are within blocks of the center, including Healeo at 15th & Madison, a juice bar and health food cafe with gluten-free options and Skillet at 14th & Union (lines form about an hour after the Skillet opens, so try to get there early. It's a little expensive, but tasty.). A new exercise center is just one block north at Chloe Apartments and they have day rates. Many buses are just a block or two away at Union or on Madison and can link you with all bus and light rail routes. Parking is on-street parking and many free spaces are available. The center does not have a parking lot.
